Poon Hei Lam (our Surveying Year 3 student) did a very good job by winning two great prizes, 'The Best Paper Award' and 'The Best Presenters' in this year's RICS-RISM-AALSM International Surveying Conference for Undergraduates. Organized jointly by the Royal Institution of Chartered Surveyors (RICS) Malaysian and the Royal Institution of Surveyors Malaysia (RISM) together with participating universities, this conference aims at offering a channel to undergraduates from a range of accredited surveying courses to have idea exchange, network establishment, exposure to industrial challenges in their professions.
